GETAWAY RULES

It is our desire to provide students with an excellent time of fellowship, fun and most importantly, an opportunity to grow in the Lord. With as many students as we have, it is essential that we establish some basic rules of conduct so that these goals may be achieved. Please review these rules. Your compliance is expected and appreciated.

- **1.** <u>DON'T LEAVE THE CABIN GROUNDS!</u> A counselor must supervise <u>ALL</u> activities.
- 2. Girls are <u>NEVER</u> allowed in the guys' area and guys are <u>NEVER</u> allowed in the girls' area. No "hanging out" around rooms either.
- 3. Everyone must be in their rooms by the designated times on the schedule.
- 4. All Bible studies, discussion groups, morning devotionals and group activities are <u>MANDATORY</u>
- 5. Couples must refrain from <u>ALL</u> physical displays of affection toward one another. This includes hanging on each other, hand holding, hugging, kissing, etc.
- 6. Practical jokes are not permitted.
- 7. <u>RESPECT!</u> Treat all Leaders and fellow students with respect. Treat all facilities and grounds with respect. You are financially responsible for any damages.

Failure to comply with these rules or to respect the authority of adult leaders will result in immediate dismissal from the getaway. Parents will be notified day or night and will be responsible for picking up the offending student.
